Dear Regulated Party:

This letter is being sent to you as the holder of a Class A Precursor Licence or Class B Precursor Registration Certificate under the Precursor Control Regulations (PCR) that will be expiring within the period of April 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020.

Please be advised that given the unprecedented situation we are facing with the coronavirus pandemic, the Office of Controlled Substances (OCS) is extending the expiry date of licences and registrations issued under the PCR that are currently scheduled to expire between April 1, 2020 and June 30, 2020. These licences and registrations will now expire on **September 30, 2020**. Please keep this letter in your records as confirmation of the extension.

Please be reminded that to remain in compliance with the PCR, it is your responsibility to submit a renewal application prior to September 30, 2020 if you wish to continue to conduct regulated activities with chemical precursors. Applications will be accepted starting on July 1, 2020 and should be sent to hc.precursors-precurseurs.sc@canada.ca. Please note that the OCS commits to a service standard of 60 calendar days for the processing of renewal applications from the date it is considered complete.
